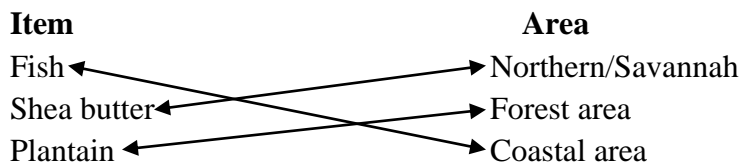
- An Ethnic group refers to a group of people who have one common ancestry.
